The Tuckamore Festival will feature our 9th annual Young Composer Program in 2021. Up to three emerging young composers will be selected to join the festival by Canadian composer and program mentor Dr. Andrew Staniland.

Between May and August, composers will participate with Dr. Staniland in group masterclasses and private lessons by distance, leading to the creation of new works that will be prepared and performed by professionals drawn from Tuckamore faculty artists and alumni. Their final performances will be recorded in high quality video and audio.

Selected composers will be asked to write a 5–10 minute work for a small chamber ensemble to be delivered (score and parts) by July 15, 2021. These works will be premiered during the 2021 Tuckamore Festival, August 9–22, 2021.

In 2021, our programs will be offered in compliance with public health directives specific to the province of Newfoundland and Labrador. If possible, the Young Composer program may include a one-week, live on site component hosted at Memorial University School of Music. A final decision will be made at the beginning of April. At that time, successful applicants will be informed by email and will receive an invoice including tuition, accommodation and meal costs, if applicable.
